Campus policy regarding procedures for students to report criminal acts or other emergencies occurring on campus:

If emergency, dial 911 from closest telephone. After calling 911, or to report any other crime, immediately go to the main office and report to Campus Director or other school official. The College will report the incident to authorities. If the student prefers, he/she may contact the authorities independently, or a staff member of the College will assist the student in notifying authorities. It is important that all crimes be reported either to the school or the local police department. Evidence of any crime should also be preserved for this purpose. The security of individuals and property is of the utmost importance to the College. The identity of the victim will be kept strictly confidential, and the alleged perpetrator will be given the opportunity to defend him/herself.

NONE of the following crimes were reported to Fountainhead College management: (1) Criminal homicide (murder and non-negligent manslaughter); (2) negligent manslaughter; (3 - 4) Sex offences, forcible and non-forcible; (5) robbery; (6) aggravated assault; (7) burglary; (8) arson; (9) motor vehicle theft; (10 - 12) arrest for liquor law, drug-related violations, or weapons possession.

NONE of the following behaviors were referred to management for disciplinary action: (1) liquor law or (2) drug-related violations or (3) weapons possession.

NO hate crimes were reported. Hate crime is described by the existence of a victim of a crime *or of intimidation* who was singled out because of actual or perceived race, gender, religion, sexual orientation, ethnicity, or disability.

For Cases of Alleged Sex Offenses: rape, acquaintance rape, or other forcible or nonforcible sex offenses:

Victim can request schedule change, if reasonably available, after sexual offense. The accuser and the accused are each entitled to the same opportunities to have others present during a disciplinary proceeding. Both the accuser and the accused shall be informed of the outcome of any institutional disciplinary proceeding brought alleging a sex offense. This does not constitute a violation of the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (20 U.S.C. 1232g). The outcome of a disciplinary proceeding is only the College's final determinations, arrived upon with respect to the alleged sex offense and any sanction that was imposed against the accused. *Sanctions may include, but are not limited to:* dismissal from the College; proof of psychological counseling before continued enrollment; and proof of compliance with all mandated judicial sentencing requirements.

The College will take steps to prevent future crimes and will report in a timely manner to the campus community on crimes including murder; rape/sex offenses, forcible or non-forcible; robbery; aggravated assault; burglary; motor-vehicle theft; offenses that manifest evidence of prejudice based on race, religion, sexual orientation, or ethnicity, as prescribed by the Hate Crimes Statistics Act (28 U.S.C. 534); and offenses that are considered by the College to represent a threat to students and employees.

Placement Rates by Program:

For the program entitled **Associate of Occupational Science in Computer Programming**, for the students who graduated, the job placement rate is 83.3%, or in the past 12 months 5 were placed in their field of study out of 6 students who graduated from this program.

For the program entitled **Bachelor of Applied Science in Computer Technology in Application Development**, for the students who graduated, the job placement rate is 20%, or in the past 12 months 1 were placed in their field of study out of 5 students who graduated from this program.

For the program entitled **Associate of Applied Science in Electronic Technology**, for the students who graduated, the job placement rate is 100%, or in the past 12 months 3 were placed in their field of study out of 3 students who graduated from this program.

For the program entitled **Bachelor of Applied Science in Electronic Wireless Communication**, for the students who graduated, the job placement rate is 100%, or in the past 12 months 2 were placed in their field of study out of 2 students who graduated from this program.

For the program entitled **Associate of Occupational Science in Health Information Management: Health Information Management**, for the students who graduated, the job placement rate is 0%, or in the past 12 months 0 were placed in their field of study out of 4 students who graduated from this program.

For the program entitled **Associate of Occupational Science in Health Information Management: Medical Coding**, for the students who graduated, the job placement rate is N/A, or in the past 12 months N/A were placed in their field of study out of 0 students who graduated from this program.

For the program entitled **Associate of Occupational Science in Information Technology**, for the students who graduated, the job placement rate is 80%, or in the past 12 months 16 were placed in their field of study out of 20 students who graduated from this program.

For the program entitled **Bachelor of Applied Science in Network Security & Forensics**, for the students who graduated, the job placement rate is 85.7%, or in the past 12 months 18 were placed in their field of study out of 21 students who graduated from this program.

For the program entitled **Associate of Occupational Science in Computer Programming**, the current withdrawal rate is 5.6 %, or in the past 12 months 18 students enrolled in this program, and 10 completed this program. Transfer-Out Rate: 0%. 5 students are still in the program.

For the program entitled **Bachelor of Applied Science in Computer Technology in Application Development** the current withdrawal rate is 10%, or in the past 12 months 10 students enrolled in this program, and 5 completed this program. Transfer-Out Rate: 0%. 4 students are still in the program.

For the program entitled **Associate of Applied Science in Electronic Technology**, the current withdrawal rate is 54.5%, or in the past 12 months 11 students enrolled in this program, and 2 completed this program. Transfer-Out Rate: 0%. 2 students are still in the program.

For the program entitled **Bachelor of Applied Science in Electronic Wireless Communication**, the current withdrawal rate is 20%, or in the past 12 months 5 students enrolled in this program, and 4 completed this program. Transfer-Out Rate: 0%. 0 student is still in the program.

For the program entitled **Associate of Occupational Science in Health Information Management: Medical Coding**, the current withdrawal rate is 40 %, or in the past 12 months 5 students enrolled in this program, and N/A completed this program. Transfer-Out Rate: 0%. 3 students are still in the program.

For the program entitled **Associate of Occupational Science in Information Technology - Online**, the current withdrawal rate is 11.8 %, or in the past 12 months 68 students enrolled in this program, and 26 completed this program. Transfer-Out Rate: 0 %. 31 students are still in the program.

For the program entitled **Bachelor of Applied Science in Network Security & Forensics**, the current withdrawal rate is 21.4 %, or in the past 12 months 56 students enrolled in this program and 18 completed this program. Transfer-Out Rate: 0%. 26 students are still in the program.
